

BUS SERVICE



For 46 years, UTA has provided public bus service to customers throughout the Wasatch Front. UTA currently serves riders in Box Elder, Davis, Salt Lake, Tooele, Utah and Weber counties, covering more than 1,400 square miles. UTA also offers express service from Salt Lake County to Park City. In 2016, UTA provided more than 19.5 million bus trips. In addition, the agency has been recognized nationally

for delivering outstanding public transportation to riders and the community.

Bus Fleet

UTA has more than 480 buses. The fleet includes hybrid-electric buses, CNG (compressed natural gas) buses, ski buses, over-the-road coaches and paratransit buses. The agency offers more than 120 routes serving approximately 6,140 bus stops.

Riding UTA

Riders can visit UTA's website to find route and schedule information, track their bus in real time or plan a trip using the UTA's trip planner. Customer service agents are also available to help riders plan their trips by calling 888-RIDE-UTA. Riders are expected to pay when boarding, and transfers to other buses, TRAX and the S-Line are free for up to two hours. Transfers to FrontRunner are available for an additional fee. All buses in UTA's fleet are accessible to riders with disabilities.
